




ADVICE

Our conservation team can:


- Undertake conservation audits and provide recommendations

Our service takes a sympathetic approach to the careful restoration of books bound in either paper, cloth, leather or vellum.





REGISTERS & RECORDS

PRESENTATION BOXES

RDW OFFER A subscription-based priority disaster recovery scheme for libraries, archives, businesses, organisations and private individuals who require a dedicated and specialist service.


The scheme provides:

PERIODICAL BINDING









RDW HAVE WORKED with many of the country's most highly regarded libraries, museums and archives, as well as local studies organisations and learned societies.

We offer a range of specialist binding services for libraries, museums, archives and other academic organisations. Bound publications can include new endpapers, incorporating library stationery if required, and features such as ribbon markers and foil blocking can be added. In addition, we are able to craft hard-wearing presentation and storage boxes and slipcases.


PERIODICALS

Periodicals, journals, magazines, newspapers and other items can be bound to individual specifications. For periodicals, adverts can be removed and title pages, contents and indexes inserted. Security triggers and barcodes can be added if required, and pockets added for CDs, maps or inserts. Degraded newspapers can be conserved, and a microfilming service is also available.

NEWSPAPERS

High quality and attractive bound volumes of newspapers help to preserve the integrity of publications in an easy-to-use format, whilst assisting in protecting vulnerable newsprint from excessive damage caused by regular referencing and handling.


Bindings are sewn and bound using waterproof library buckram or leather and are suitable for both broadsheet and tabloid formats. As an alternative to full binding we also provide storage boxes and folders to accommodate any sized newspaper.

A full scanning and digitisation service is also available for newspapers should this be required.

Older, degraded copies of newsprint and bound volumes of papers can be conserved. Estimates can be supplied following close examination by our conservation staff.



MUSIC

Our staff are able to rebind music or convert it from paperback to hardback, binding either in cloth or using the original cover. Music can be repaired or re-sewn if necessary, allowing it to lie flat when open. Pockets can be incorporated for individual scores, which in turn are rebound using stiff card covers or cloth, and the parts lettered in black or gold.

REFERENCE

Reference and local studies binding is designed to extend the useful life of valuable or rare books that are likely to need a strong, long-lasting binding.

Books are bound using waterproof library buckram as standard, but we can use other cloths and leathers if requested.

Pockets can be added on the inside back board to house loose inserts, folded maps or CDs. Security triggers and barcodes can also be added to books before returning them.



REGISTERS

Records, registers and minutes can be neatly and securely organised by having loose items bound into one tidy volume. Our bindings are covered by a 10-year guarantee and provide a sturdy, hard-wearing case.

SPECIAL BINDINGS



We have a long-standing tradition of creating fine edition bindings for particularly special, treasured or valuable publications in both traditional and contemporary styles.


